A "Talent show" was conducted and the children were dressed up as "Birds" and spoke about the uniquetries and its significance.




PRIMARY





RESEARCH SKILLS SESSION BY MERVA

A series of research skills sessions were conducted by Ms. Meenakshi Krishnaraj of Merva. The objective of the session was to hone the research skills among the students of class XI. The sessions helped students understand the basic concepts of research - primary research, secondary research and the process of writing a research. Students were introduced to various steps involved in research, starting from



identifying a topic, doing background research, narrowing down on the topic, citations and abstract writing. Sessions were interactive with students doing rounds of discussions in breakout rooms. Students submitted a research paper on their favorite topic at the end of the session.


