# **KARADI PATH - ORIENTATION**

A workshop for teachers was held on 26.3.'24 for an orientation on the Karadi Path Programme. It commenced with a concise introduction to the Grades I &



II Karadi Path-Power English Program, designed to cultivate English proficiency, and prioritize language advancement among students. The primary objective is to enhance children's speaking skills. Multiple methods are employed to achieve this objective, such as incorporating Dolch words, engaging in finger-tracing while reading aloud, leveraging music-infused rhymes to improve listening abilities, and integrating story-time activities. The program encompasses several key components, including blends and sounds, vocabulary acquisition, phonics, nar-

rative segmentation (story), syllable segmentation, and informal grammar exploration.
